There are 1300 public libraries in Moldova where you can effectively promote your project or business ideas.



In 2014:

800,000 unique users visited Moldovan libraries;

250 librarians have been trained in IT and community mobilization strategies;



6,000 community members were trained in utilizing IT;

237,000 m² are available to promote ideas and activities.

In the coming years, with help from Novateca and other partners, the number of public library users is projected to increase considerably. By utilizing libraries to promote your objectives, services, and activities, your potential audience is expanded easily and effortlessly!

Partnership ideas to explore...

Public organizations and agencies:

- Providing IT trainings for public organizations' employees;
- Holding open community events for increasing visibility and advertising services;
- Hosting conferences and meetings;
- Debating public strategies and community initiatives;
- Disseminating brochures, flyers and publications, etc;

Private sector:

- Product placement;
- Market research;
- Training on products and services;
- Disseminating brochures, flyers and publications, etc;

NGOs and other community actors:

- Promoting and hosting events and services for specific target groups, such as doctors, farmers, social workers, young people etc.;
- Holding training events;
- Hosting exhibitions and demonstrations;
- Disseminating information materials.

STARTING A PARTNERSHIP WITH PUBLIC LIBRARIES



- Talk to the librarian about the event you would like to organize;
- Estimate the necessary resources and approve them with the librarian (budget, time, co-workers etc.);
- Develop the event program;
- Inform the community;
- Involve volunteers and other partners;
- Together with the librarian, evaluate the event and suggest ideas for improving your collaboration.
